

The Presentation Ball gives all those involved the opportunity to socialise in a supportive environment. It is about having fun and learning how to conduct oneself in a more formal setting and enables participants to establish and further develop friendships and friendship groups.

It is an introduction to dancing and etiquette in a formal setting that teaches behaviours which are transferable to any number of social occasions and future business life. It provides the setting that allows our students to not only dress up but to learn the behaviours which go hand in hand with such a presentation.

COSTS INVOLVED

The Presentation Ball Coordinators endeavour to keep costs to a minimum. The costs are set out below.

Full payment for each Presentee is required by **Wednesday 10 May 2023** to secure a place. You must complete the package payment and information through the *Humanitix* website: https://events.humanitix.com/tintern-grammar-presentation-ball-2023

Select **Presentee Package 1 (Dress)** or **Presentee Package 2 (Suit)**, then complete payment and registration. This will be open to book into from Wednesday 26 April to Wednesday 10 May 2023.

- Many of the couples choose to organise a limousine (estimated around \$60 \$80 each for a limo with 8 people).

Cancellation & Refund Policy

Withdrawal from the Ball before **Wednesday 31 May 2023** will incur a \$50 fee plus incurred *Humanitix* costs.

Should any cancellations occur after this date, refunds of the Total Package Cost may not be possible.

DANCE CLASSES AND REHEARSALS

Professional dance instructors from *Sassi Dance* conduct all dance classes. Classes will be held on Thursday evenings from 4.00pm onwards in the Tintern Gym. The first class commences on Thursday 13 July 2023.

It is requested that on the first night of Dance Class, parents attend a short briefing (6.45pm – 7.00pm) held by the Ball Coordinators at the end of dance class. This is to give parents an opportunity to ask any questions and for the Coordinators to outline what is expected from all participants.

Our Full rehearsal will be on Monday 4 September 2023 at **The Centre Ivanhoe** from 5.45pm – 8.00pm. This is a vital rehearsal and we ask that parents and presentees make an early note of this date to keep it available. Presentees should wear the shoes which they will be wearing on the night of the Ball.

Please ensure your presentee is on time to all dance classes and that you are on time

to collect them at the end of dance class. Presentees are asked not to leave the gym area until their parents have arrived to collect them. As per the Parental Consent form if the presentee is unable to attend class please contact Josie on 0409 954900 before the class commences. If we have not heard from you and the Presentee does not attend we will endeavour to contact you and confirm their well-being.

If an emergency arises and you need to contact a presentee during dance class please phone one of the Coordinators on their mobile numbers as listed on page 4.

All presentees are asked to dress appropriately for dance class. Strapless tops or dresses, tight skirts or short dresses should not be worn. Presentees are also required to wear appropriate footwear throughout the dance classes. These can include runners or soft soled shoes. No heeled shoes, thongs or bare feet. School shoes are not permitted on the gym surface.



CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

- No smoking or drinking of alcohol or use of illegal substance is allowed by any presentee at the Ball or dance classes regardless of age
- No alcohol will be served to under age guests (this is a legal requirement which will be enforced)
- All presentees must remain in their presentation attire for the duration of the evening (until 12 midnight)
- Act in a respectful manner at all times, both at the Ball and throughout dance classes
- No photos or filming during dance classes

DRESS CODE

- No facial jewellery is to be worn and no more than one earring in each ear
- No tattoos are to be shown cover up with makeup
- Hair must be of a natural looking colour
- No strapless gowns
- Straps must remain on for the entire evening including all photographs.
 (This will be enforced throughout the evening).



SUITS

Suit hire includes the suit, shirt, vest, tie/cravat and shoes. *Trevor Dudley's Classic Menswear Formalwear & Hire* will meet those wearing suits at dance class to measure and fit. The cost of the suit hire is included in Presentee Package 2.

After dance class on **Thursday 20 July** *Trevor Dudleys Classic Menswear Formalwear & Hire* will be at school to measure and fit suits. **All those wearing suits must be in attendance.**

The suits will be distributed at the end of rehearsal on **Thursday 31 August.** Please note that black socks are to be worn with the suit.

This is the families' responsibility. Parents are to complete the form at the back of the booklet, as some parents in the past have not been fully informed by their child regarding their suit hire and requirements for return.

GOWNS

The evening is based on the more traditional style Ball, with the wearing of **white floor length dresses**. Please note - off white, cream or ivory dresses are not acceptable.

Dresses should represent modesty and good taste and be suitable for ballroom dancing. The dresses **must have** some type of shoulder strap or halter neck. *Strapless or midriff baring styles or dresses with high slits well above the knee are not permitted.* We ask parents for their support in this regard.

Please make sure the dress hemline is not touching the floor, as this creates a problem for you and your partner particularly when coming down stairs. Past experience has shown that the dress will drop a couple of centimetres during the evening. Also consider the width of your straps, as very

thin spaghetti straps in previous years have cut in due to the weight of many of the dresses and have become very uncomfortable during the evening. Please also ensure any straps added to dresses are well attached and robust enough to last the evening. Straps have broken at the last minute prior to presenting on the night!

We suggest backs should be no lower than a normal bra strap position. Please note that your bodice should fit snugly - we do not want an embarrassing situation to arise. Body tape is good to adhere to the dress and then either to your bra or skin.

White elbow length gloves will be provided. These are included in the package and will be brought to the final rehearsal (Thursday 7 September).



Shoes

White or silver shoes only.

Strapless shoes must not be worn as many have slipped off on the night and caused embarrassment. Consideration should be given to a comfortable heel height as it is a very long rehearsal day and evening. When purchasing your shoes please ensure they fit snugly to your foot. Your foot should not move within your shoe when dancing.

Please wear COMFORTABLE SHOES! In the past we have had many problems associated with shoes. These include broken heels, broken straps, blisters (heaps) and bleeding

feet. It cannot be stressed enough that once a pair of shoes have been purchased, spend as much time as possible wearing them to ensure less problems on the night. It is also required that the actual shoes be worn for the full rehearsal at *The Centre Ivanhoe* on 4 September. Your shoes will be checked at the rehearsal and if necessary, you will be advised if extra strapping is required. If your shoes have leather soles, please scuff them to minimise slipping.

For those wearing suits, shoes are already included as part of the package.



GUEST TICKETS

We welcome all family and friends to be part of the Presentation Ball - a once in a lifetime experience. Tickets for the evening are available through *Humanitix*: https://events.humanitix.com/tintern-grammar-presentation-ball-2023

Tickets will be available for purchase from Friday 21 July 2023 until Wednesday 3 August 2023. Any request for tickets after these dates will be considered but not guaranteed.

There are three categories of tickets – Adult, 17 & under, and 10 & under tickets.

Adult \$150.00

- A three course meal, champagne, wine, beer and soft drinks, coffee and tea
- Entertainment

17 & under \$125.00

- A three course meal, soft drinks, coffee and tea
- Entertainment
- No alcohol will be served to under age guests

10 & under \$100.00

- A three course meal and soft drinks (children's menu)
- Entertainment

Legal ID is required at all times. The management of *The Centre Ivanhoe* has the right to request ID and to refuse any person alcohol should they see fit to do so.

Tables of up to 10 are available and any special requests for seating with family/ friends or special dietary requirements/allergies must be noted in the booking.

The Coordinators will do their best to fill all requests and we ask that parents complete the *Humanitix* booking process in full to enable correct seating and ordering of special meals.

Please be aware that tickets may be limited depending on number of presentees. On the night of the Presentation Ball guests must present their tickets on arrival to ensure entry.

Food Allergies

Levels of reactions to allergens vary, with some reactions being simply due to proximity (airborne) and others occurring only after consumption of the allergen.

Please be aware that *The Centre Ivanhoe* is unable to guarantee there are no allergens in the food and beverages served during the function.

The Centre Ivanhoe and the client will discuss all guest food and beverages requirements with a view to minimising the likelihood of reactions. If you have any further concerns, please contact us.



ARRIVAL ON THE NIGHT

On the afternoon of the Ball all Presentees must arrive at *The Centre Ivanhoe* at 4.00pm. They will be greeted upon arrival and filmed by our professional recording team as they exit their vehicle and enter the reception rooms. The early arrival is to allow for official photographs and a full rehearsal of dances and presentation.

The Presentees will have some time to relax and freshen up after dance rehearsals and official photographs. Light refreshments for the presentees will be served in the Withers room prior to guests arriving, and this area is set aside throughout the afternoon for the use of the Presentees.

Back packs and carry bags are not to be brought to *The Centre Ivanhoe* – a small cosmetic bag or purse is acceptable. If a change of clothes is necessary for later in the evening, parents are to bring this when they arrive. Any bags will be checked by security as you enter *The Centre Ivanhoe*.



Recording of the Event

A professional recording team will be present on the day and night of the Ball, filming the formal presentations, participants' dance sets and capturing the atmosphere of the night with informal footage. This will all be provided as a link, available approximately 8 weeks after the Presentation Ball which will be emailed to all families. Presentees will be advised when they are ready. The cost of the recording is included in your package.

PHOTOGRAPHS



Our official photographers will take single, couple and a group photograph of the Presentees which will be available to order online two weeks after the Ball. These are available for purchase; the cost depends on the number of photos purchased.

Before the guests arrive, photos will be taken of the Presentees by themselves and with their partners. There will also be photos of friends within the Presentation set and a group shot of the whole Presentation set.

After the formal presentation, our photographers will take photos of family and friends.



Recommendations for makeup

Be mindful of wearing glossy or shimmer foundation makeup. Whilst this is okay for effect, it is not ideal for photography and videos.

Our photographers use bright lighting for photography and this can cause large ugly white highlights on foreheads when shiny makeup is worn. They suggest you use powder to avoid these highlights.

Using your own cameras when our Official Photographer is working

Getting everybody in a group, all having a great expression and all looking into the lens at the same time is a challenge and almost impossible when other people are trying to shoot over their shoulder. Our photographers therefore request that you do not bring your own cameras with you when you come up for family photos. We ask that you please understand their position if they refuse to take your family photos if others are doing likewise with their own cameras.

PRESENTEE PROFILES

As each couple is presented to the Official Guests, the MC will read out a profile about each Presentee. Please consider carefully what you would like to have read out and try to make it interesting; remember everyone at the Ball will be listening to all of these carefully.

Please supply the following information for presentation on the night of the Ball.

Descriptive paragraph

Please write about 50 to 60 words which may include:

- How long you have attended Tintern (for partners their school/Uni/work details)
- Most admired person and why
- Philosophy on life (e.g. keep a promise, take a chance and learn from your mistakes)
- Highlights or special achievements, hobbies, interests, aims and ambitions in life.

Ensure that your name is written in the way you would like to be addressed i.e. Matt or Matthew, Kate or Katherine. A sample paragraph could read as follows:

Stephanie is a Year 11 student at Tintern. Stephanie has been dancing since she was 4 years old and still loves to dance around the house. She is a keen netballer and enjoys a good laugh with her friends. Her most admired person is her mum and dad as they are both caring and loving. Stephanie's philosophy in life is "All your dreams can come true if you have the courage to pursue them" She hopes to have a career in health sciences, travel the world and have fun.

Or

A Handsome Chap - Derek's friends describe him as a king amongst men. Derek's outlook towards life is based around his motto "Hakuna Matata" which means 'no worries' – this can lead to problems where homework is involved. His interests are as varied as tennis, guitar, skiing and the joys of smelling a fresh photocopy page. He would like to thank Ashley for being a fabulous partner and comment on how lovely she looks tonight.
